Message from Education Director: Tips for Better Dancing

How to Avoid Breaking Down:

1. Keep the set small. Touching hands immediately after each call is one way to accomplish this.
2. Always have your set lined up with the walls. Often a set will become slightly offset from being lined up with the walls, and a Cast Off or other turning motion may cause some people to become disoriented. If the caller has the square Promenade and has the heads or sides Wheel Around, it is quite likely the set will not be lined up with walls. Solution: Take it upon yourself to make slight adjustments on the next two or three calls to get the set aligned with the walls.

If You Become Completely Lost:

1. Do not turn around. This will make it difficult for someone behind you to help you recover. It is much easier to guide someone into place by guiding them from the back.
2. Turn your head in all directions to see where you should go. If someone says to turn around or you see that you should turn around, then do it. Otherwise, retain your facing direction and let someone guide you into place.
3. Do not wander around. Stay put until someone either guides you into place or directs you to go to a certain position. Do not be surprised to receive this help-expect that you will receive it and be ready to respond to it quickly.

If Your Square Breaks Down, Get To Facing Lines:

Do this by squaring your set and then have the head couples slide to the right to form normal facing lines of four (each boy with a girl on his right). Now watch the other squares. Often the caller will get the squares back to facing lines several times before finally getting to a Left Allemande. When he does get the floor to facing lines, your square can now pick up the next call and you are dancing again. You may not finish with your original partner or corner, but you are dancing and that is the name of the game. This will not work every time, as sometimes the caller does not bring people back to facing lines before a Left Allemande; but it works often enough to be worth doing. In fact, many callers will intentionally bring people back to facing lines in order to pick up those who have broken down early.

Caller / Cuer of the Month: Andy and Lanita Turner

The Caller of the Month for June is Andy Turner and his lovely wife, Lanita. Andy not only serves as Associate Caller for Territorial Squares in Guthrie but also has served several terms as club president.



We square dancers in Central District are very fortunate to have associate callers like Andy who will someday move up to being club callers.

Andy and Lanita Turner were married in December 1963 while he was in the Air Force and stationed at Carswell AFB in Fort Worth, Texas. Their daughter Terri was born in 1965 in Fort Worth, Texas. Terri is now married and has two sons.

Andy and Lanita graduated from square dancing classes in September 1980 in Italy where Andy was stationed. Their daughter Terri took lessons before them and after they watched her dance a few times, they wanted to learn also. Classes were conducted by a caller named Ed Williams of the Sand Castle Swingers in Naples, Italy. Ed Williams was also in the military and was due to rotate to the United States in June of 1981. Andy began calling after Ed said he had

watched him sing all of the singing calls when he danced. Andy took over as the club caller in June 1981, and called until his rotation to the United States in June 1982.

Shortly after arriving at White Sands Missile Range in New Mexico, Andy became the caller for the Missile Twisters. He called for them until he was reassigned to Maxwell AFB, Alabama in January 1984. Since there was no need for an additional caller at that time, Andy and Lanita became dancers. Unfortunately, Lanita's back problems caused them to stop dancing.

Andy retired from the Air Force with 26 years of service in 1987. He worked for Southeast Health Plan in Birmingham, AL until 1996 when he and Lanita moved to Guthrie. They moved to Guthrie to be near family members, after losing a sister, brother-in-law and one of their grandchildren in the 1995 Murrah building bombing.

In the fall of 2004, they were invited to attend classes with the Territorial Squares in Guthrie. After only a few classes, it was determined that they could dance well enough to join the club. In early 2005, Andy got the urge to call again. Lawrence Biggs took him under his wings and allowed him to call for the club. Andy has also called dances for Happy Tracks in Edmond.

Andy Turner stays busy with Central District activities. Along with being both president and associate caller for the Territorial Squares, he called two Central District demonstrations in the month of May and will call another one in June. Dedicated people like Andy and Lanita are the ones who keep square dancing alive and well. Thank you Andy and Lanita for your many contributions to Territorial Squares and to Central District.
