## Central District 2011 Blood Drive has been Cancelled:

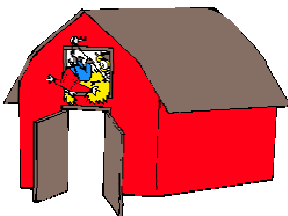


The 2011 Central District blood drive has been cancelled due to the lack of donors.

## **Outstanding Square Dance Couple of the Month:**

The outstanding square dance couple for March is Steve and Stacey Palmer from Happy Tracks. These two are very active in square dancing and have served as Presidents of Happy Tracks. They have also served several years in various offices on the Central District Executive Board. Steve and Stacey are such a fun couple and are most deserving of being our Outstanding Square Dance Couple of the Month.



Steve and Stacey Palmer have been married for nearly sixteen years. He is originally from Vermont and she from the state of Washington. Steve received his Bachelors degree in Electrical Engineering from the Memphis State University in 1979. He interviewed for a job with the Boeing Company and was hired shortly before graduating. He relocated to Renton, WA where The Boeing Company has several big plants. It was there in Renton that Steve began his career as an engineer. Stacey graduated from Washington State University with a Bachelors in Child and Family Studies in 1982.

Steve and Stacey met each other at a church singles group. It was love at first sight for both of them! Their first date started very early - Steve invited Stacey to the unveiling of the 757 airplane, a plane he had been working on and the tickets were for 6 am. After dating for a several months, things got serious and Steve popped the big question. They were married in their church in May, 1995. While living in Kent, they became interested in ballroom dancing. They took ballroom dance lessons through a recreational club sponsored by The Boeing Company, and have been happily dancing ever since.

The Boeing Company has contracts with the Air Force and Steve was transferred to Oklahoma City in 2002 to work at Tinker AFB as an electrical engineer. They had to move quickly since the company wanted him to start in 30 days. They bought a house in one week and moved shortly afterwards to Choctaw. They were introduced to square dancing during an exhibition at their new church. There were several couples in their church that danced with a local square dance club called Happy Tracks. Steve and Stacey had been looking to continue their ballroom dancing but all the dance clubs were on the west side of Oklahoma City. It wasn't easy to get involved in ballroom dancing or find a place to dance. With the smaller number of Boeing employees in Oklahoma City, there was no recreation club like there was in Washington.

The square dance club in Choctaw seemed just what they were looking for and they soon started lessons. Dick Manning taught the first set of lessons and they joined Happy Tracks upon graduating. They said that they really enjoyed the friendly people in Happy Tracks and learned how true it is that square dancing is, "friendship set to music."

Steve and Stacey continued square dance lessons through a short-lived program called Jump Start. It consisted of six weeks of lessons on Saturdays for four hours with a different caller each week. Steve said it was hard on the callers but it gave him and Stacey a chance to hear the different callers in Central District and know which clubs they might want to check out.

After completing two sets of lessons, Steve and Stacey jumped into square dancing and became active members of their club. They were elected President the second year they danced with Happy Tracks. After that, they were offered positions on the Central District Board and have held the offices of Education Director, Social Secretary, and Executive Secretary. It was during their first year on the Executive Board that Steve started taking pictures at square dances and Central District activities.

Steve's hobby is photography and he's an excellent photographer. Thus, he was soon appointed the Central District Photographer. You can check out Steve's work by logging on to the Central District web site and clicking on "Pictures" on the home page. He takes a lot of pride in his photographs and really enjoys taking good pictures. Stacey said he's already worn out one lens since taking this job.

When asked to name a memorable time or event in square dancing, Stacey said dancing in the Centennial Parade in 2007 in downtown Oklahoma City comes to mind. She has never done as much dipping and diving as she did then. Steve and Stacey's worst moment was at the Reba McIntire & Vince Gill concert at the Centennial Celebration. The square and round dancers were to run into the Ford Center and dance, but no one could hear the cue due to the audience cheering and yelling as Reba and Vince took the stage. It was mass confusion for a while but all the dancers got through it okay.

In closing, we appreciate all that Steve and Stacey have contributed to Happy Tracks and to Central District during the time they have been members. You can be sure that you will have a great time if you are ever fortunate enough to meet them in a square. They are a fun, energetic couple and have been very willing to step up and help out when needed. We are grateful to the two of you for your many contributions to square dancing.

## Message from the Education Director: Visit Nine



The purpose of this article is to answer questions about the Visit 9 Program. We will first discuss what it is. We will then discuss the cost of this program. Last, I would like to tell you why I enjoy the program and why I participate in it.

The Visit 9 program encourages square dancers to visit all of the districts in the State. It is coordinated by the Oklahoma Square Dance Federation. Oklahoma has 9 square dance districts: Central District, Northwest, Northeast, North Central, Panhandle, South Central, Southern, Southwest and Green Country. Each of these districts usually has two Visit 9 dances each year normally put on by the district boards. The 2011 Visit 9 Dances are listed on the Calendar on the OSDF website: <http://www.squaredancing.com/osdf/> and in the Sashay newsletter.

The cost of the Visit 9 program is minimal. You'll need to purchase a Visit 9 badge and at each dance, you'll need to purchase a dangle for the badge. The badge can be purchased at the dances as well.

I have found that the Visit 9 program is enjoyable. I have met many new people while visiting the different districts. It also allows me to hear different callers in the state and enjoy their calling. In addition, I have carpooled with others to these dances. It gave us the chance to visit and get better acquainted.
